

Tuning Directions

DO NOT loosen the two screws holding the keys. Minor adjustments to pitch can be made by tapping the keys (to raise) or (to lower) pitch.

Playing Directions

To play your thumb piano, lightly depress a key with your thumb (about 1/32 of an inch, or less). With the key still depressed, slide your thumb off the key, letting it snap back.



Note: A darkening of the brass tube and oxidation of the keys is normal. It does not affect the playability or tone of the instrument.
